Identifield Problems/Concerns

- 1. Increased numbers of pupils increasing pedestrians/bikes/cars.
- 2. Increased number of parents increasing pedestrians/bikes/cars.
- 3. Increased number of staff further pressure on limited parking.
- 4. Taxi drop off/collection of SSC pupils.
- 5. Increasing HGV/goods vehicle traffic:
 - insufficient turning space for larger vehicles;
 - delivery times coinciding with staff arrivals and children coming to/from school:
 - due to hot meal provision this has already increased to 5 days per week.
- 6. Parking on bend of road.
- 7. Potholes.

 - 1. Talks in assemblies to address safety/healthy living.
 - Information in 'New Starters' pack.
 - Road safety education.
 - Footsteps programme.
 - Bikeability.
 - Junior Citizen.

 - Provision of cycle/scooter parking.
 - 2. Parent Post reminders re parking, children's safety, speed, bikeability.
 - Banners about zig-zag lines.
 - PCSO presence.
 - Promotion of 'Car Free' day eg WOW! (Walk on Wednesday). Road Lavout

To alleviate the problem with traffic, a one-way system would address the majority of these issues. As a school the safety of our children is paramount, and we believe all efforts should be made to ensure this is addressed.

- 3. Promote healthy travel.
- 4. Ensure Taxi forms are aware of designated drop off/pick up point.
- 5. Ensure drivers are aware of safety of all, and times to avoid congestion. See 'road layout'.
- 6. Provision of bollard to prevent parking on road bend.
- 7. Approach roads to school and temporary car park opposite school need attention to ensure safety of pedestrians when cars deviate and safety of traffic. Promote healthy travel.
